










iCarta2 Diagram

Bluetooth Pairing


How to Pair your Device with iCarta2
Bluetooth Range 10 meters / 32 feet



- 1. Turn on Bluetooth function of mobile device.
- Press & hold Power (A) for more than 5 seconds. The unit will say "Pairing".
- 3. Select the speaker shown on your mobile device.
- 4. Input passkey "0000" or "1234" if required. (Default passkey for the majority of Bluetooth devices.)
- 5. Once pairing is complete the LED (B) status indicator will guickly flash.
- 6. Select and Play audio selection from your mobile device.
- 7. Press VOL- (C) or VOL + (D) to adjust speaker volume.




- Once pairing is complete, Select and Play audio selection from your Mobile device.
- 2. Press VOL- © or VOL + D to adjust speaker volume.
- You can also adjust the Output Volume levels from your Mobile device

Optional Power Setup

Using micro-USB Cable for Power Source (not included)

Minimum Power 5V-1A up to Maximum 5V-3A



- Connect the micro-USB Cable to the micro-USB plug (F) located on the bottom of the iCarta2.
- Then plug the USB AC-Adapter into the wall power outlet.
 Minimum Power 5V-1A up to Maximum 5V-3A
- 3. Now you will have continuous power without the use of batteries.

Warning: Do not exceed Power current of 5 Volts / 3 Amp, doing so will cause damage to speaker unit.
